MORNING MESSAGE

“What’s Your Story?”

Acts 22:1-21

- I. HIS LIFE BEFORE HE MET JESUS (vv.3-5)
 - A. He was a religious man (v.3)
 - 1. Romans 10:1-3, “Brethren, my heart’s desire and prayer to God for Israel is, that they might be saved. For I bear them record that they have a zeal of God, but not according to knowledge. For they being ignorant of God’s righteousness, and going about to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted themselves unto the righteousness of God”
 - B. He was a ravaging man (v.4)
 - 1. Acts 8:3, “As for Saul, he made havock of the church”
 - C. He was a relentless man (v.5)
 - 1. Galatians 1:14, “And profited of the Jews religion above many my equals in my own nation, being more exceeding zealous of the tradition of my fathers”
- II. HOW HE MET JESUS (vv.6-16)
 - A. He saw the vision of the light (vv.6-7a)
 - B. He heard the voice of the Lord (vv.7b-11)
 - 1. He was surprised by the voice (v.7b)
 - 2. He was shocked by the voice (v.8)
 - 3. He was sent by the voice (vv.9-11)
 - C. He received a visit from a layman (vv.12-16)
 - 1. The visitation (vv.12-13)
 - 2. The information (vv.14-15)
 - 3. The transformation (v.16)
- III. HIS LIFE AFTER HE MET JESUS (vv.17-21)
 - A. He was a praying man (v.17)
 - B. He was a preaching man (vv.18-20)
 - C. He was a persuaded man (v.21)
