## MORNING MESSAGE

"5 Heads of Let Us"

## Hebrews 10:19-25

- I. LET US DRAW NEAR GOD (v.22)
  - A. The writer suggested how to draw near to God
    - 1. Draw near with a "true heart"
    - 2. Draw near with a "pure heart"
- II. LET US HOLD FAST (v.23)
  - A. Here are two marks of the genuinely saved
    - 1. They will hold fast
    - 2. They will have hope
- III. LET US PROVOKE ONE ANOTHER (v.24)
  - A. The Christian life was not designed to be lived alone
    - 1. We are to "consider" one another
    - 2. We are to "provoke" one another
- IV. LET US ASSEMBLE WITH ONE ANOTHER (v.25a)
  - A. This is the only negative statement in the passage
    - 1. "Assembling together" is only found twice in scripture
      - a. In Hebrews 10:25 it refers to the church assembling on earth
      - b. In 2 Thessalonians 2:1 it refers to the church assembling in the air
    - 2. "Forsake" means to abandon, leave behind, or desert
- V. LET US EXHORT ONE ANOTHER (v.25b)
  - A. The church is a place of encouragement
    - 1. There is an imperative: "exhorting one another"
    - 2. There is an incentive: "as ye see the day approaching"
