“The Doxology of Job”

Job 1:20-22

- I. THE PROPEROUS VERSE – “The Lord gave”
 - A. The prosperity is described in Job 1:1-5
 1. The Lord gave a good man (1:1)
 2. The Lord gave a great man (1:2-3)
 - a. His family (v.2)
 - b. His farm (v.3a)
 - c. His fame (v.3b)
- II. THE PERILOUS VERSE – “the Lord hath taken away”
 - A. The peril is described in Job 1:13-19
 1. The Lord took his crop performers – oxen & donkeys (1:14-15)
 2. The Lord took his clothing producers – sheep (1:16)
 3. The Lord took his caravan providers – camels (1:17)
 4. The Lord took his crowning possession – children (1:13, 18-19)
- III. THE PERPLEXING VERSE – “blessed be the name of the Lord”
 - A. The perplexity is described in Job 1:6-12
 1. The conversation with Satan (1:6-8)
 2. The charge of Satan (1:9-11)
 - a. The first charge (v.9)
 - b. The further charge (v.10)
 - c. The final charge (v.11)
 3. The commission of Satan (1:12)
