

CAMP GUIDELINES

1. Follow the camp schedule faithfully. Everyone must attend all activities and be ON TIME.
2. There is no free time without counselor supervision.
3. No one is allowed in to a room without a counselor's knowledge.
4. NO pranks, raids on other rooms, sneak-outs, or unsupervised hikes. Anyone caught out of their room without permission after "lights-out" will be sent home!
5. The boy's cabins are off limits to the girls, the girl's cabins are off limits to the boys. Campers will be sent home for violation of this guideline with no questions asked.
6. Always bring your Bible and Camp Guide to worship and family group sessions.
7. Clothe yourself modestly. See page 7 of this book for the camp dress code.
8. Cell phones - cell phones are to be used to communicate with your leaders and family as needed during the week, any misconduct will result in your phone being taken until we return to WBC.
9. Any campers that need to take prescription meds, the meds must come to camp in the original prescription container and labeled for the camper's use, with dosing instructions. Likewise, if you are sending particular over-the-counter meds, they must be in the original packaging. All meds must be turned in to the Camp Nurse before departure to be dispensed at camp.
10. Treat each other, all adults, facilities, and property with respect.
11. NO fireworks, firearms, knives, cherry bombs, flame-throwers, throwing stars, or nuclear weapons.
12. NO tobacco, drugs, alcohol, synthetic drugs, e-cigarettes.
13. NO POPDA (Public or Private Displays of Affection).
14. Anyone breaking these rules will be sent home at the expense of the parents with no refund.
