

CAMP DRESS CODE

1 Peter 3:3-4 says: “Do not let your adorning be external, the braiding of hair and the putting on of gold jewelry, or the clothing you wear. But let the heart with the imperishable beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which in God’s sight is very precious.” In aligning with God’s Word we ask that all campers wear modest clothing while at camp. Here are the dress code guidelines for AMPWEEK21.

Shirts...

1. Shirts must cover midriff area (bottom of shirt must meet the top of the lower attire when hands are raised).
2. No tube tops, no spaghetti straps, no crop tops, no halter tops.
3. Shirts must have two straps, for girls - tank tops must completely cover undergarments, for boys - tank tops cannot have large arm holes.
4. Shirts must not be too tight or low cut.
5. Shirts must not display any offensive pictures or foul language.
6. Boys must wear a shirt in public areas when not at the pool.

Shorts...

1. Shorts must not be excessively tight or excessively short when standing, sitting or bending.
2. Shorts must not be transparent when wet.
3. Leggings are allowed but you must wear a shirt long enough to cover your bottom.

Swimsuits...

1. It is preferred that girls wear a one-piece swimsuit. However, tankini’s that are long enough to cover the midriff are allowed. A dark colored t-shirt or tank top (tank top rules from above apply) must be worn at all times over a two-piece swimsuit.
2. Cover-ups must be worn to and from the pool area.
3. Guys should wear trunk style swim shorts, no speedos allowed.
4. Guys must wear a shirt to and from the pool area.
