MORNING MESSAGE

“The Unchanging Jesus”

Hebrews 13:8

- I. THE PAST JESUS – “Jesus Christ the same yesterday”
  - A. He is the eternal Jesus
    1. John 1:1-3, “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by him; and without him was not anything made that was made”
  - B. He is the incarnate Jesus
    1. John 1:14, “And the Word was made flesh and dwelt among us”
  - C. He is the sinless Jesus
    1. Hebrews 4:15, “but was in all points tempted like was we are, yet without sin”
  - D. He is the crucified Jesus
    1. Luke 23:33, “And when they were come to the place called Calvary, there they crucified him”
  - E. He is the resurrected Jesus
    1. Luke 24:1-6, “Now upon the first day of the week, very early in the morning, they came unto the sepulcher, bringing spices which they had prepared, and certain others with them. And they entered in, and found not the body of the Lord Jesus. And it came to pass as they were much perplexed thereabout, behold, two men stood by them in shining garments: And as they were afraid, and bowed down their faces to the earth, they said unto them, Why seek ye the living among the dead? He is not here, but is risen”
  - F. He is the exalted Jesus
    1. Acts 1:9, “And when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, he was taken up: and a cloud received him out of their sight”
- II. THE PRESENT JESUS – “and today”
  - A. He is the seated Jesus
    1. Mark 16:19, “So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God”
  - B. He is the speaking Jesus

1. Hebrews 7:25, "he ever liveth to make intercession for them"

C. He is the saving Jesus

1. Luke 19:10, "For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost"

D. He is the satisfying Jesus

1. Philippians 4:11, "I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, therewith to be content"

E. He is the securing Jesus

1. John 10:28, "And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand"

F. He is the seeking Jesus

1. Revelation 3:20, "Behold, I stand at the door and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him"

### III. THE PERPETUAL JESUS – "and forever"

A. He is the returning Jesus

1. Acts 1:11, "Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? This same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven"

B. He is the reigning Jesus

1. Revelation 20:6, "Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years"
