“The Song of Songs”

Song of Solomon 1:1; 2:7,16

INTRODUCTION

A. There are three books in the Bible that were penned by Solomon

1. The book called Proverbs

a. Proverbs 1:1, “The proverbs of Solomon the son of David, the king of Israel”

2. The book called Ecclesiastes

a. Ecclesiastes 1:1, “The words of the Preacher, the son of David, king in Jerusalem”

3. The book called Song of Solomon

a. Song of Solomon 1:1, “The song of songs, which is Solomon’s”

I. THE ASSERTION OF THE SONG (1:1)

A. It was penned as a song (v.1a)

B. It was penned by Solomon (v.1b)

1. 1 Kings 4:32, “And he spake three thousand proverbs; and his songs were a thousand and five”

II. THE ADMONITION OF THE SONG (2:7)

A. It was penned to the daughters (v.7a)

B. It was penned as a deterrent (v.7b)

III. THE ADMISSION OF THE SONG (2:16)

A. This is a marriage verse

1. Genesis 2:24, “Therefore shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh”

2. Ephesians 5:31, “For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh”

B. This is a mutual verse

1. Titus 2:3-4, “The aged women likewise...that they teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands”

2. Song of Solomon 4:16, “Awake, O north wind; and come, south wind; blow upon my garden”
