“The Soulwinner’s Psalm”

Psalm 126:6

- I. OUR TASK – “He that goeth forth”
 - A. Our task is personal – “He”
 - B. Our task is purposeful – “that goeth”
 - C. Our task is penetrating – “forth”
- II. OUR TEARS – “and weepeth”
 - A. Our tears reflect our care
 - B. Our tears reflect our compassion
 - C. Our tears reflect our convictions
- III. OUR TREASURE – “bearing precious seed”
 - A. Our treasure is pure
 1. Luke 8:11, “Now the parable is this: The seed is the Word of God”
 - B. Our treasure is precious
 - C. Our seed is powerful
- IV. OUR TRIUMPH – “shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him”
 - A. Our triumph includes a promise
 - B. Our triumph includes some praise
 1. Luke 15:6, “Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep which was lost”
 2. Luke 15:9, “Rejoice with me; for I have found the piece which I had lost”
 3. Luke 15:23-24, “Bring hither the fatted calf, and kill it; and let us eat and be merry: for this my son was dead, and is alive again; he was lost and is found. And they began to be merry”
 - C. Our triumph includes a prize
 1. “Sheaves” are bundles of grain
