MORNING MESSAGE

“The Grace of Giving”

2 Corinthians 8:1-9

- I. THE EXTRAVAGANCE OF GRACE GIVING (vv.1-5)
  - A. Grace giving is not limited by poverty (vv.1-2)
  - B. Grace giving is not lifted by pressure (vv.3-4)
- II. THE EXPECTATION OF GRACE GIVING (vv.5-8)
  - A. Grace giving is not lacking in performance (vv.5-7)
  - B. Grace giving is not legislated by power (v.8)
- III. THE EXAMPLE OF GRACE GIVING (v.9)
  - A. His riches – “For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich”
    1. He was rich in His person
    2. He was rich in His possessions
    3. He was rich in His position
  - B. He Resignation – “he became poor”
    1. He resigned Himself to servanthood
    2. He resigned Himself to suffering
    3. He resigned to Himself to become sin
    4. He resigned Himself to be a sacrifice
  - C. His Reason – “that ye through his poverty might be rich”
    1. He makes us rich in the present
    2. He makes us rich in possibilities
