MORNING MESSAGE

“Some Things Worth Remembering”

2 Timothy 2:8-13

- I. REMEMBER THE PREEMINENCE OF GOD’S SON (v.8)
  - A. Remember His royalty – “that Jesus Christ the seed of David” (v.8a)
    1. 2 Samuel 7:16, “And thy house and the kingdom shall be established forever before thee: and thy throne shall be established forever”
    2. Luke 1:30-33, “And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favor with God. And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name Jesus. He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord shall give unto him the throne of his father David: and he shall reign over the house of Jacob forever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end”
  - B. Remember His resurrection – “was raised from the dead according to my gospel (v.8b)
    1. Romans 1:3-4, “Concerning his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh; And declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection of the dead”
- II. REMEMBER THE POWER OF GOD’S WORD (v.9)
  - A. Remember Paul’s explanation – “Wherein I suffer trouble as an evil doer, even unto bonds” (v.9a)
  - B. Remember Paul’s exclamation – “but the word of God is not bound” – (v.9b)
    1. Philippians 1:12, “But I would ye should understand, brethren, that the things which happened unto me have fallen out rather unto the furtherance of the gospel”
    2. Philippians 4:22, “All the saints salute you, chiefly they that are of Caesar’s household”
- III. REMEMBER THE PRIORITY OF GOD’S MISSION (v.10)
  - A. Remember the reason for Paul’s endurance – “I endure all things for the elect’s sake” (v.10a)
  - B. Remember the result of Paul’s endurance – “that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory” – (v.10b)
    1. John 14:6, “I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father but by me”
    2. Acts 4:12, “There is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved”
    3. Romans 10:14-15, “How shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? And how shall

they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach, except they be sent? As it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things”

IV. REMEMBER THE PROMISE OF GOD’S FAITHFULNESS (vv.11-13)

- A. Remember the death verse – “If we be dead with him, we shall also live with him” (v.11)
  - 1. Romans 6:8, “Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him”
- B. Remember the distress verse – “If we suffer, we shall also reign with him” (v.12a)
- C. Remember the denial verse – “If we deny him, he also will deny us” (v.12b)
  - 1. Matthew 10:33, “But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven”
- D. Remember the doubting verse – “If we believe not, yet he abideth faithful: he cannot deny himself” (v.13)
