“Luke – The Vicarious Death of Jesus”

Luke 23:32-46

INTRODCUTION

A. Luke is named three times in Scripture

1. Colossians 4:14, “Luke, the beloved physician and Demas greet you”
2. 2 Timothy 4:11, “Only Luke is with me”
3. Philemon 24, “Marchus, Aristarchus, Demas, Lucas, my fellow laborers”

B. Luke is the author of two books in your Bible

1. The Gospel of Luke
2. The Acts of the Apostles

1. Romans 3:23, “For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God”
2. Ephesians 1:7, “In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins”

1. John 10:28, “I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand”

1. Acts 20:32, "And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace"

C. It was a word of success

1. Isaiah 53:5, "But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed"
2. 2 Corinthians 5:21, "For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him"
3. 1 Peter 3:18, "For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God"
