INTRODCUTION

- A. Luke is named three times in Scripture
 - 1. Colossians 4:14, "Luke, the beloved physician and Demas greet you"
 - 2. 2 Timothy 4:11, "Only Luke is with me"
 - 3. Philemon 24, "Marchus, Aristarchus, Demas, Lucas, my fellow laborers"
- B. Luke is the author of two books in your Bible
 - 1. The Gospel of Luke
 - 2. The Acts of the Apostles
- I. A WORD OF INTERCESSION (v.34)
 - A. It was a word of prayer
 - B. It was a word of pardon
 - 1. Romans 3:23, "For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God"
 - 2. Ephesians 1:7, "In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins"
 - C. It was a word of possibility
 - 1. 1 John 1:9, "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness"

- III. A WORD OF INVOCATION (v.46)
 - A. It was a word of security
 - 1. John 10:28, "I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand"
 - B. It was a word of surrender

C. It was a word of success

- 1. Isaiah 53:5, "But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed"
- 2. 2 Corinthians 5:21, "For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him"
- 3. 1 Peter 3:18, "For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God"
