“John – The Victorious Resurrection of Jesus”

John 20:11-29

INTRODUCTION

- A. The author of this book is John the Apostle
 - 1. John was a fisherman by trade
 - 2. John is the author of at least five books in your Bible
 - a. Three epistles: 1,2,3 John
 - b. One book of prophecy: Revelation
 - c. One gospel: John
 - 3. John wrote to convince us that Jesus is the Son of God and to believe in Him
 - a. John 20:31, “But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name”

- I. THE WEEPING DISCIPLE SAW HIM (vv.11-18)
 - A. The weeping disciple is Mary Magdalene
 - B. The weeping Mary saw the risen Lord
 - 1. Mary’s despair (v.11a)
 - 2. Mary’s discussion (vv.11b-15)
 - a. Her discussion with the guardians (vv.11b-13)
 - b. Her discussion with the gardener (vv.14-15)
 - 3. Mary’s discovery (vv.16-18)

- II. THE WORRIED DISCIPLES SAW HIM (vv.19-23)
 - A. The worried disciples are the ten; not the twelve
 - B. The worried disciples saw the risen Lord
 - 1. They were concerned (v.19a)
 - 2. They were calmed (vv.19b-20)
 - 3. They were commissioned (vv.21-23)

- III. THE WONDERING DISCIPLE SAW HIM (vv.24-29)
 - A. The wondering disciple is Thomas

B. The wondering disciple saw the risen Lord

1. Thomas was cynical (vv.24-25)
2. Thomas was confronted (vv.25-27)
3. Thomas was convinced (vv.28-29)
