 - A. “Sound words” are doctrine or teachings
 1. Grasp the sounds words (v.13)
 - a. 1 Timothy 6:20, “O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust”
 2. Guard the sound words (v.140)
- VII. REVIEW YOUR FRIENDSHIPS (vv.15-18)
 - A. Be careful of your friendships
 1. Paul exposed his enemies (v.15)
 - a. “Turned away” means forsook, deserted, or abandoned
 - b. He named two: Phygellus and Hermogenes
 - c. 1 Timothy 5:20, “Them that sin rebuke before all, that others also may fear”
 2. He exalted his encourager (vv.16-18)
 - a. He named one: Onesiphorus
 - b. He sought me (v.17a)
 - c. He found me (v.17b)
 - d. He refreshed me (v.16)
