MORNING MESSAGE

“Six Strong Stewardship Statements”

Psalm 24:1, 1 Corinthians 4:2, Malachi 3:10, 2 Corinthians 9:7, 1 Corinthians 16:2, Luke 6:38

- I. GOD OWNS EVERYTHING – “The earth is the Lord’s and fullness thereof, the world, and they that dwell therein” (Psalm 24:1)
 1. Exodus 19:5, “Now therefore, if ye will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people; for all the earth is mine”
 2. Psalm 50:10, “For every beast of the forest is mine, and the cattle upon a thousand hills”
 3. Haggai 2:8, “The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, saith the Lord of hosts”
 4. Deuteronomy 8:18, “But thou, shalt remember the Lord thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth”
- II. GOD REQUIRES FAITHFULNESS – “Moreover it is required in stewards that a man be found faithful” (1 Corinthians 4:2)
 1. Luke 16:2, “And he called him, and said unto him, How is it that I hear this of thee? Give an account of thy stewardship”
- III. GOD COMMANDS TITHING – “Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house” (Malachi 3:10)
- IV. GOD LOVES CHEERFUL GIVERS – “Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity; for God loveth a cheerful giver” (2 Corinthians 9:7)
- V. GOD EXPECTS EQUAL SACRIFICE – “Upon the first day of the week let everyone of you lay by him in store, as God hath prospered him, that there be no gatherings when I come” (1 Corinthians 16:2)
- VI. GOD REWARDS GIVERS – “Give, and it shall be given you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again” (Luke 6:38)
