MORNING MESSAGE

“A Heart Like His”

1 Samuel 13:14

I. HIS HEART IN PREPARATION

A. It was a harmonious heart

1. 1 Samuel 13:14, “the Lord hath sought him a man after his own heart”
2. Acts 13:22, “I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after mine own heart”

B. It was a humble heart

1. 1 Samuel 16:11, “There remaineth yet the youngest, and behold, he keepeth the sheep”

C. It was an honest heart

1. Psalm 78:72, “So he fed them according to the integrity of his heart”
 - a. “Integrity” means uprightness; he was bone-deep honest

II. HIS HEART IN PRACTICE

A. It was a calculated heart

1. He calculated the reward (17:25)
2. He calculated the reproach (17:26)
3. He calculated the reason (17:29)

B. It was a confident heart

1. 1 Samuel 17:37, “The Lord that delivered me out of the paw of the lion, and out of the paw of the bear, he will deliver me out of the hand of this Philistine”

C. It was a courageous heart

1. 1 Samuel 17:45-47

III. HIS HEART IN PERIL

A. It was a capable heart

1. 2 Samuel 11:1, “And it came to pass, after the year was expired, at the time when kings go forth to battle that...David tarried still at Jerusalem”

B. It was a convicted heart

1. Numbers 32:23, “be sure your sin will find you out”
2. 2 Samuel 12:13, “I have sinned”

C. It was a confessing heart

1. There was recognition (Psalm 51:1-5)
2. There was repentance (Psalm 51:6-11)
3. There was restoration (Psalm 51:12-19)
